## **SOIL EROSION AND SEDIMENTATION CONTROL**

(When a permit from the Environmental Health Division may be required)

- **If your project involves disturbing soils over an area of one (1) or more acres.** A SESC permit from the Allegan County Environmental Health Department will be required as part of your zoning/building permit application submittal packet.
- **If your project is within 500 feet of a lake, stream, river, drain, or other water body.** A SESC permit from the Allegan County Environmental Health Department will be needed as part of your zoning/building permit application submittal packet.
- **If you are building an agricultural/accessory building,** a SESC permit from the Allegan County Environmental Health Department may be required as part of your zoning/building permit application submittal packet.
- **If your construction project is for a permanent dwelling and / or large-scale additions to an existing homes.** A SESC permit from Allegan County Environmental Health Department may be required as part of your zoning/building permit application submittal packet.
- Zoning/building applications for items such as decks, porches, swimming pools, small additions, and small accessory buildings generally do require a SESC permit. This does not preclude the fact that a site visit may determine that a Soil Erosion and Sedimentation Control permit may be required by Allegan County Health Department.
