

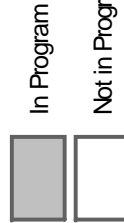
Who Can Use This Service?

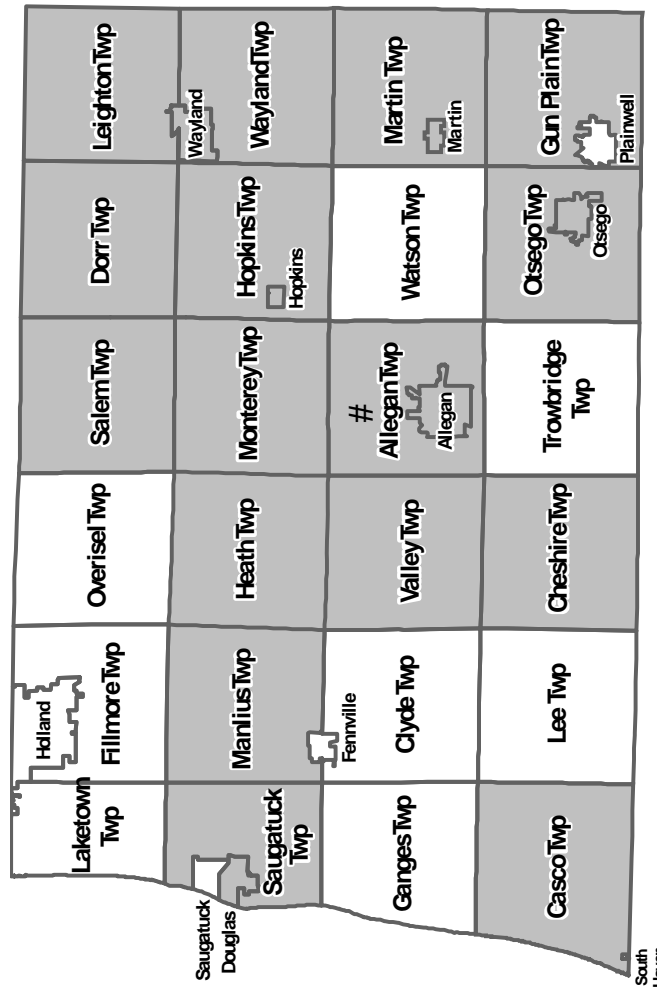


Communities in Resource Recovery Program

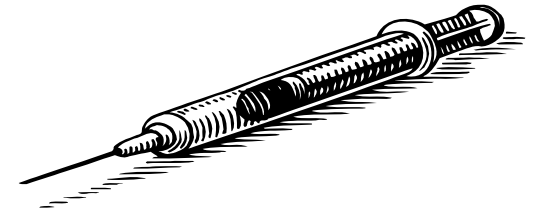

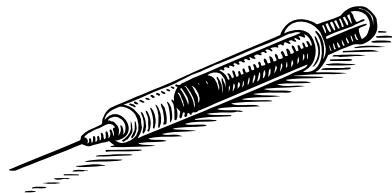

Allegan County Residential Sharps Collection Program

Through the Allegan County Resource Recovery Program, residents are allowed to drop off used sharps at the Allegan County Health Department.

Please follow these guidelines:

1. Contact the Allegan County Health Department, Environmental Health Office at (269) 673-5415 to pick up an approved sharps container.
2. Take container home and fill with used sharps. Do not fill over the "Fill-line." **Sharps accepted are: Needles, Syringes, Lancets and other Sharp Objects. (Contaminated needles shall not be bent, recapped, or removed.)**
3. Bring sharps container back to the Allegan County Health Department, Environmental Health Front Desk. Ask for Ben Williams.
4. Take another sharps container home. There will be two sizes to choose from. Only one empty container will be dispensed at a time.
5. See map on reverse side of brochure. If you live in a Township or City that is **not** in the Resource Recovery Program, read the next section of the brochure to learn how to participate.



For Those Residing in a Non-Participating City or Township

If you reside in a city or township which does NOT participate in the Allegan County Resource Recovery program, the following criteria must be met:

1. Visit the Allegan County Health Department, Environmental Health Office in the Human Services Building at the Allegan County Services Complex, 3255 122nd Ave, Allegan.
2. Request a Resource Recovery Card. This annual card costs \$30 and will provide sharps containers and disposal of sharps for one year.
3. Make check payable to "Allegan County Resource Recovery."



The Allegan County Resource Recovery Sharps Program is the best way for residents to protect the environment, waste haulers and others from the dangers of sharps!
