Community Novel H1N1 clinics in Allegan County

Allegan — the Allegan County Health Department is working with Allegan Healthcare Group, Inc. to offer the 2009-nH1N1 influenza vaccine to the CDC's target groups in community settings. The 2009-nH1N1 vaccine is currently available in a combination of settings such as health department clinics, healthcare provider offices, and other private settings, such as pharmacies and workplaces.

The next scheduled community off-site clinics will be in Hamilton and Otsego to allow for access from different parts of the county. To schedule an appointment for one of these clinics, call 269-686-4350 from 9:00 am- 6:00 pm, M-F. Before calling, please contact your primary doctor/healthcare provider since he or she might have the 2009-nH1N1 vaccine available. Many primary providers are getting this vaccine directly shipped to them. Additional community clinics will be scheduled as more vaccines become available.
