Allegan —Community Novel H1N1 vaccination clinics are available for all individuals to protect them in the New Year. In the past, pandemic influenza had third waves of infections; the timing could be the post-holiday season when people are returning to their normal activities such as work or school. The Allegan County Health Department continues to work with Allegan Healthcare Group, Inc. to offer the 2009-nH1N1 influenza vaccine to the general population in community settings.
