Allegan County Health Department continuing n-H1N1 FREE vaccination clinics in the evening

Allegan — In the past, pandemic influenza had waves of infections so the current pandemic influenza, Novel H1N1 continues to be a risk to people.

Because of this risk, Allegan County Health Department is continuing weekly NO COST evening Novel H1N1 vaccination clinics. These FREE clinics are every Tuesday from 5:00pm-8:00pm and open to all populations. These clinics are by appointment only and are filling the schedule at a rapid rate, call 269-673-5411 for more information

Individuals need to take advantage of these FREE clinics so they are protected from future resurgence of this infection.

In other words, the more people who are vaccinated against Novel H1N1 this year, the less likely the H1N1 virus, will spread and take hold in next year influenza season.

This looming concern over another wave of Novel H1N1 is even more reason, to continue aggressive “anti-flu” efforts, from washing your hands (or using hand sanitizers), to covering your cough or coughing into your sleeve, staying home when sick and being vaccinated against both seasonal and Novel H1N1 influenza.
