The Recycling Station

Residents can drop off single stream commingled recycling at the recycling station located next to township hall.

This site is under surveillance and residents that leave trash, furniture, appliances, paint, and other materials not listed increase the expense of this station.

What to bring

- Cardboard & Paper board
- Magazines, newsprint, paper, & junk mail
- Cartons
- Glass bottles & jars
- Plastic containers #1-7
- Metal cans, pie plates, & foil



- Empty containers
- Rinse & dry containers
- Leave the caps on
- Flatten cardboard boxes
- Respect the recycling station & property
- Follow the guidelines



- No food or soiled items
- No hazardous materials or electronics
- No large plastic items
- No clothes
- No plastic bags
- No styrofoam

HHW can be dropped off by appointment at the Allegan County Health Department. Contact 269-673-4559 to schedule an appointment.

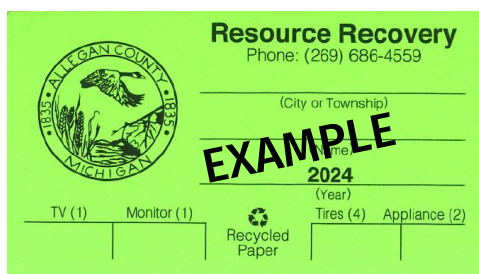
Batteries may be recycled at township hall. Battery collection buckets are located at the front entrance.

- Pesticides, herbicides, insecticides, fungicides, & rodenticides
- Oil based paints, stains & varnish
- Paint thinner & solvents
- Motor oil, grease, anti-freeze
- Batteries
- Cleaners
- Aerosols
- Compressed gas cylinders
- Small propane tanks
- Mercury containing items
- Acids & Bases
- CFL & Fluorescent bulbs

Resource Recovery Cards are available at township hall. Call 269-673-5051.

Use your resource recovery (recycling) card to recycle tires (4), Styrofoam, appliances (2), TV (1), monitor (1), other electronics, and scrap metal at these regional recycling depot sites.
