Recycling Information

Monterey Township residents are eligible for curbside recycling service. Sign up by contacting Allegan County Resource Recovery at (269) 673-5415.

- Recycling collection occurs every 4 weeks on Wednesday. Please remember to place your cart out the night before your scheduled pick-up.
- Residents may also contact Republic Services at (877) 698-7274 to report a missed pick-up.

What to recycle

- Cardboard & Paper board
- Magazines, newsprint, paper, & junk mail
- Cartons
- Glass bottles & jars
- Plastic containers #1-7
- Metal cans, pie plates, & foil



- Empty containers
- Rinse & dry containers
- Leave the caps on
- Flatten cardboard boxes
- Respect the recycling station & property



- No food or soiled items
- No hazardous materials
- No large plastic items
- No clothes
- No plastic bags
- No styrofoam



Regional Recycling Depots:

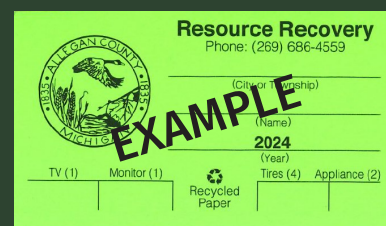
Your Resource Recovery Card allows you to recycle: tires (4), styrofoam, appliances (2) (stoves, microwaves, dishwasher, refrigerator), TV/ Computer, and metal.

Salem Township Transfer Station is open the *1st and 3rd Saturdays of the month (Closed Jan & Feb)

- Salem Township Transfer Station, 4145 29th Street is open from 8:00am-3:30pm. (site also provides bulk trash service for a fee.)

Broken Arrow Recycling, 1100 Lincoln Rd, Allegan, is open
